

Carpet Base

INSTALLATION

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Required Equipment

The following items may be purchased from a local carpet workroom supplier:

- · Razor knife
- · Straight Edge/Square
- · Cove Base Adhesive
- 3/32" trowel or caulking gun with nozzle

General Installation Procedures

- 1. Insure that all pile direction is running in the same direction. This is important to keep a consistent look.
- 2. Unroll base next to the wall, face down.
- 3. Apply adhesive to the back of the carpet being careful not to get within 1/4" of edges.
- 4. Start in a corner or door frame by firmly pressing the carpet base in place to ensure the adhesive is making solid contact. Continue working the base to the wall by putting a slight stretch on the base to prevent wrinkles.
- 5. Inside corners may be cut or pressed firmly into the corner. Outside corners should be wrapped around. Extra adhesive may be necessary on outside corners.
- 6. Carpet base should be cut from the back with a straight edge/square. When cutting, place the piece on top of cardboard or wood to prevent damaging the existing flooring.
- 7. Carpet base should be cut flush with door frames.

If the base is stapled to the wall, indentions may be seen. Mohawk does not recommend this method of installation.
